PROJECT MANAGER

ROLE OUTLINE

As a project manager, you'll be responsible for supporting the sign-off at design stage, through to the off-site build & then deployment of the unit(s) on-site. You will ensure that projects are within a realistic timescale & budget. This involves working with our trusted supplier partners & keeping the client up to date. You will have the following duties:

- Understanding what the client wants to achieve.
- Agreeing timescales, costs and resources needed to deliver a project.
- Drawing up a detailed plan for how to achieve each stage of a project.
- Negotiating with contractors and suppliers
- Communicating with staff at every level, in a calm, personable way
- Overseeing several projects at the same time
- Ensuring that each stage of the project happens on time, on budget and to a high standard.
- Reporting regularly on progress to the client and stakeholders
- Coordinating market and customer research
- Resolving any issues or delays
- Demonstrating knowledge of all areas of construction

REQUIREMENTS

ROLE PACKAGE

WORKING HOURS – FULL TIME EMPLOYED ROLE

Currently Powercube offers a 4 Day Working Week (4DWW) with no pay reduction. The specific day off in the week TBC according to our 4DWW terms. Powercube doesn't operate a formal flexi-time system or pay regular overtime.
